

## ORDINANCE NO. 827

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PALOUSE, WASHINGTON, amending Ordinance Nos. 167 and 765, and Palouse Municipal Code §8.12.050, thereby reducing restrictions on materials which signs can be made of.

The City Council of the City of Palouse do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Palouse Municipal Code §8.12.050 and those portions of Ordinance Nos. 167 and 765, which are codified as Palouse Municipal Code §8.12.050, are hereby amended to read as follows:

**“8.12.050 Signs. It is unlawful to erect, construct, place or maintain over or across any sidewalk or portion thereof within the limits of the City any signboard, trade sign, banner, flag or any other device calculated or intended to advertise or call attention to any trade, business, occupation, profession or calling that extends out over the sidewalk from the structure to which it is attached a greater distance than three feet, nor be less than 10 feet in the clear above the surface of the sidewalk thereunder.**

**All signs and devices permitted herein shall be securely fastened to the building to which they are attached and in no instance shall the same be fastened to any post or other object on or at the outer edge of the sidewalk.”**

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after it or a summary thereof, is published in the official newspaper of the City of Palouse as required by law.
