

The Palouse Food Pantry Information Sheet - 2016

The Palouse Food Pantry serves the residents of Palouse, Washington in the 99161 zip code, by providing supplemental food to those in need. The Palouse Food Pantry is sponsored by the Council on Aging in Colfax, WA. Each month the Palouse Food Pantry receives commodities from the Council on Aging in conjunction with 2nd Harvest in Spokane, WA. Other sources of food comes from individual donations, food drives throughout the year from different organizations, and the purchasing of food from monetary contributions to the Palouse Food Pantry. Periodically, we also receive fresh produce from local growers in the area, which is greatly appreciated.

The Palouse Food Pantry is staffed by friendly local volunteers, and is located in the Calvary Chapel, 215 E. Church St., Palouse, WA 99161.

Our normal **distribution** day is **Wednesday, of the last full work week**, each month, from 1:00 - 2:00 pm and 4:30 – 6:00pm.

Our goal is to help local residents prepare healthy and nutritional meals using recipes designed to use with the commodities.

Donations are always welcome here at the Palouse Food Pantry. Donations of non perishable food made be purchased or left at McLeod Market, or at Needful Things thrift store. If you wish to make a monetary contribution, it can be made out to Palouse Food Pantry, P.O. Box 326, Palouse, WA 99161. Also, for those who grow fruits and vegetables, if you have an over abundance in your garden, the Food Pantry will always welcome good and fresh produce, just call 509-595-3048, and we can make arrangements with you to distribute them where needed.
